OPERATIONAL COSTS


SMS reduces costs bygiving users an all-in-one security management system. Furthermore, the need for paper records and documents is eliminated.

SMS' powerful modules and reporting features allow users to collect comprehensive records of events through documents, signatures and images.





SMS reduces administrative tasks considerably by eliminating time consuming manual procedures. This allows users to quickly view, gather and store necessary data.




SMS incorporates the latest technologies such as biometrics and touch compatibility, guaranteeing security procedures are executed precisely and up to standard.
